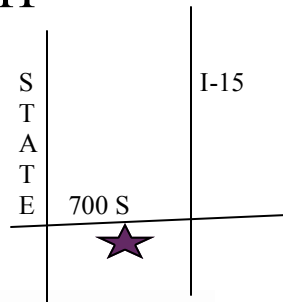


WEAR PURPLE

RETT SYNDROME IS A DEVASTATING NEURODEVELOPMENT DISORDER CAUSED BY A MUTATION OF THE MECP2 GENE THAT MAINLY AFFECTS FEMALES, AND WHEREAS, EVERY TWO HOURS, A GIRL IS BORN WITH RETT SYNDROME, BUT ITS SYMPTOMS USUALLY DO NOT APPEAR UNTIL 6 TO 18 MONTHS OF AGE. THIS DISORDER AFFECTS FAMILIES WORLDWIDE. IT DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE AS TO RACE, COLOR, OR CREED, AND IT HAS NO BOUNDARIES; AND WHEREAS GIRLS ARE GENERALLY BORN HEALTHY THEN THEY BEGIN TO SHOW SIGNS OF REGRESSION. THEY LOSE THEIR ABILITY TO SPEAK, (HENCE THE NAME "SILENT ANGELS") WALK, PERFORM BASIC MOTOR SKILLS, AND DEVELOP SEIZURES AND SCOLIOSIS. ONSET AND SEVERITY CARRIES FROM CHILD TO CHILD, AND WHEREAS, APRAXIA IS ONE OF THE SYMPTOMS, WHERE THERE IS AN INABILITY TO CARRY OUT PURPOSEFUL MOVEMENT; AND WHEREAS, PUBLIC AWARENESS OF RETT SYNDROME IS EXTENDED TO THE MEDICAL COMMUNITY, THERAPISTS, TEACHERS, CAREGIVERS, AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC AND WILL CONTINUE UNTIL THERE IS A WORLD WITH NO RETT SYNDROME.
